Fanni's Yellow Book is the second in a series of 10 small books, about the imaginative play of Fanni. Currently nominated for one of the prestigious prizes at the 28. *Biennale of Illustrations Bratislava* and sold in translation to China Mainland and South Korea.

Inger Tobiasen is one of the best-known Danish illustrators of children's books – with her recognisable style, she catches the sentiments of children beautifully and she has provided artwork for many books, also by other authors.

Fanni misses the sun at night when she can't see it. She tries to paint it with her yellow colour, but it gets crooked, she turns it into a lemon. Now Fanni paints many different yellow things. Eventually she paints a yellow balloon, and with it she flies up and says good morning to the sun.
