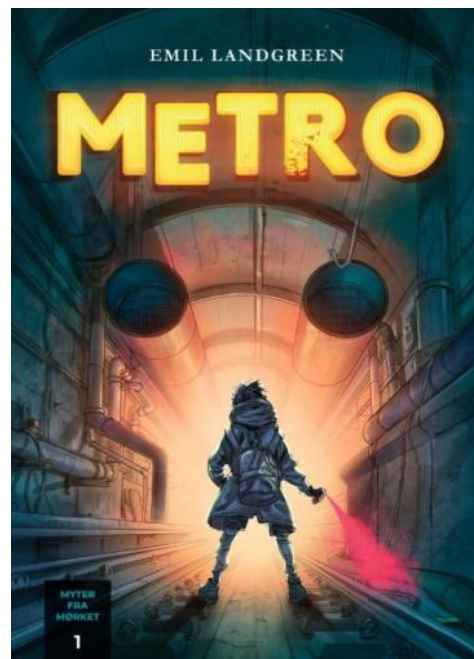
But the children apparently don't know the underground and the creatures that live there as well as they think...
