Siri Melchior has already proved that her illustration style travels, her books having been published in Germany and Spain.

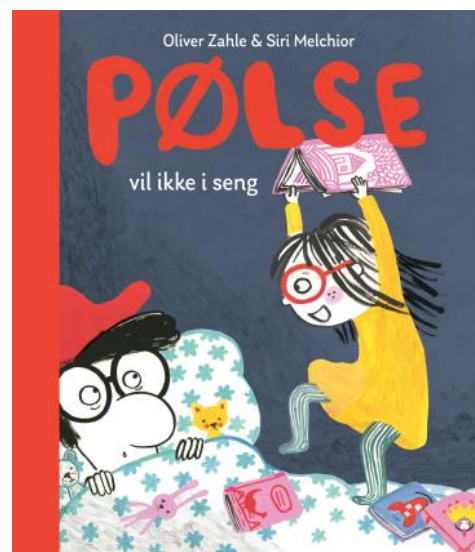
SYNOPSIS
