Silent Worlds is an ambitious techno-thriller about fictional realities - and about technology that can change people. There are a total of four books in the series and *The False Lives* is the second installment. It won the prestigious Danish award, *Best Fantasy Novel of the Year* in 2023 and Boris won again in 2024 with the third book - he is only author to have won two years in a row.

Boris Hansen (b. 1981) is award-winning Danish writer of fantasy and sci-fi and script writer on the much-anticipated new game, *Out of Words* (Epic Games, 2026 release).

SYNOPSIS

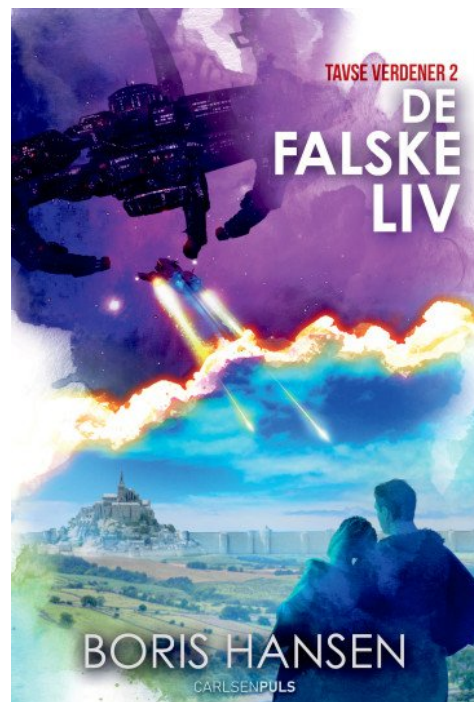
