A philosophical, aesthetic and well-written picture book about a small boy and all his thoughts before he goes to sleep. Aimed at 4+ and their parents.

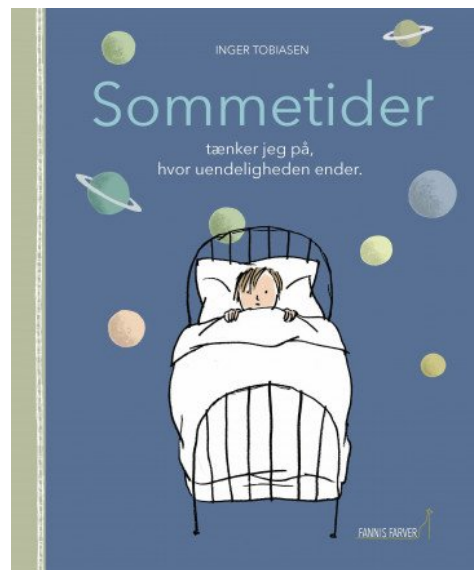
