The boy in Inger Tobiasen's lovely and heart-warming picture book has an avalanche of thoughts – about sleeping fish, the universe, love and the origin of words – all to keep the one thought he does not want to think about at bay – the thought about his best friend, Carla, and the bad thing he did...
