Den dag Leopold blev forelsket

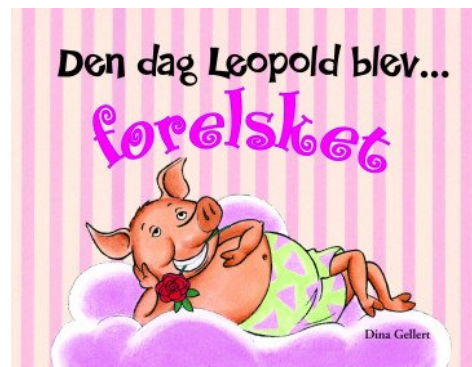
A Danish children's book classic, the picture book series now counts 8 books, as well as memory games and a cute teddy. The books are about emotions, something that never goes out of fashion. On the contrary, talking about emotions is more relevant now than ever before.

Dina Gellert (b. 1961) has drawn a wealth of children's books and her style is often described as happy, naive and humorous in the best senses of the words.

SYNOPSIS

Leopold is standing on the 10 metre diving platform. I can't believe he has the guts! Is it because he's incredibly brave? Or a fantastic swimmer? Or is it just to enjoy the view? No, Leopold is in love!

The stories about Leopold are humorous, and the language is subtle without any finger-pointing, even though the subject matter can be quite serious. It all takes place in a fun pig universe with lots of funny pig expressions. There's always a basis for a good laugh - for both children and their grown-ups - and a good chat about emotions!
