### Den dag Leopold blev forelsket

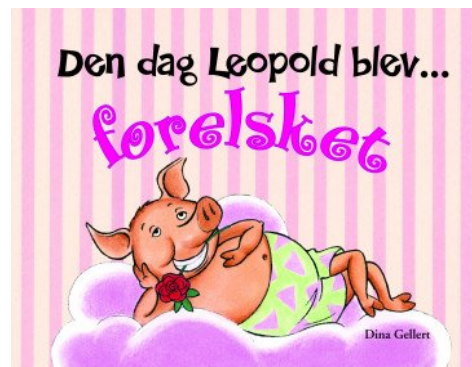

**Dina Gellert** (b. 1961) has drawn a wealth of children's books and her style is often described as happy, naive and humorous in the best senses of the words.

### SYNOPSIS

*Leopold is standing on the 10 metre diving platform. I can't believe he has the guts! Is it because he's incredibly brave? Or a fantastic swimmer? Or is it just to enjoy the view? No, Leopold is in love!*

The stories about Leopold are humorous, and the language is subtle without any finger-pointing, even though the subject matter can be quite serious. It all takes place in a fun pig universe with lots of funny pig expressions. There's always a basis for a good laugh - for both children and their grown-ups - and a good chat about emotions!
