Sara Ejersbo (b. 1980) studied Comparative Literature and attended the Copenhagen Writers' School for Children's Literature. She made her debut in 2012 with *The Zombie Cat* and has since published almost 60 books for children and adults.

SYNOPSIS

On Halloween, a frightened guest checks into Hotel Hanegal. He recently bought a new house but is sure it's haunted, so he doesn't dare sleep there anymore!

Frida and Frederik realise there must be a logical explanation, so they offer to stay in the house until they find it. Who is making noise and leaving footprints in the house at night? Can they uncover the invisible guest before the poor owner is forced to give up his dream home?
