Sara Ejersbo (b. 1980) studied Comparative Literature and attended the Copenhagen Writers' School for Children's Literature. She made her debut in 2012 with *The Zombie Cat* and has since published almost 60 books for children and adults.

SYNOPSIS

The wolf has returned to the forests behind Hotel Hanegal, but not everyone is thrilled. A nature guide takes Frida and Frederik on a trip to spot the shy animals, but one of the pack's cubs is missing.

When Frida and Frederik soon find a trap hidden in the forest, they are sure that someone has been hunting the protected animals. The police think it's just nature's way and won't do anything about it until there is more evidence. Can Frida and Frederik solve the mystery of the missing wolf cub before more of them disappear?
