They cannot escape the city, as it is under siege by the enemy's soldiers and all bridges across the river have been destroyed.

But one night as they are searching for food and water, they loose their way in the bombed-out streets of the city and they end up at the river. Here they find something that they did not expect...

A bestseller in Denmark and winner of several awards, the series is sold in eight translation markets so far. There are currently six books in the series and a 7th planned for Christmas 2025.

Sophie Souid is an award-winning Danish children's book author known for her great humourous writing.

Thomas Hjorthaab is a well-known Danish children's book illustrator whose art style is known to be funny, punk and bursting with emotion.



In the third book, teenage boy, Ziggie, and his vengeful, cunning cat, Kitty Poo, continue to blame, fight and love to hate each other.

However, a small distraction enters the scene, as Ziggie's small cousin, Marie, comes to visit. Suddenly, someone wants to play with Kitty Poo. She calls him Sweetie Pie and Farty Poopy and she is in general a terrible brat. In fact, here is for once something Kitty Poo and Ziggie can agree on. Kitty Poo puts his evil plans to eradicate Ziggie on hold and decides to teach Cousin Marie a lesson. But it does not go according to plan. Not at all, actually...

The first book, KITTY POO: REVENGE IS SWEET AND REEKS OF FISH! won the Best Graphic Novel of the Year Award by The Copenhagen Libraries.

Both the first and second books were nominated for the Ping Prize.

The fourth book is currently nominated for the Orla Prize.

SYNOPSIS

In a house on a hilltop, the autistic boy, Frede, and his older sister are home alone. A violent storm has hit their area and all land around them has been washed away by flooding, leaving their hilltop house on a small island in the sea. They are without electricity and light, waiting for their parents to find them.

Fred's sister does everything in her power to create an illusion that everything is normal – to protect her fragile younger brother. She plays with dinosaurs, makes a cozy camp underneath the dining table, bakes pancakes on the gas fire and tells a fairy tale of a girl who lives in the sea.

At the same time, she is worried and scared. Where are their parents? Will the water rise further? And how does she make the old generator in the outhouse work, so that she can create light and signal to the helicopter above that they are alive and waiting?

The book provides a beautiful and moving point of departure for a dialogue on climate change and on the importance of caring for each other when the going gets tough. There is a strong sense of hope and community in the story and the stunning illustrations provide a complete extra layer of meaning for this pearl of a story.
