



Anne Sofie Hammer is one of the most popular Danish children's books writers, and author of the bestselling series about Villads from Valby.



Mette Vedsø (b. 1968) studied chemistry and biotechnology, then trained at the Writer's School for Children's Literature. Since 2010, she has written several critically acclaimed children's books, including picture books and tween novels. Her work is suffused with an implicit understanding for children, especially the slightly displaced ones with big hearts her observations and writing are moving, subtle and poetic.

There is cool uncle Don in London and nasty Elvira who has the class in her iron grip.


There is Lulu from Aarhus, who has changed way too much since last summer.


